

LADBROKES CHALLENGE CUP SEMI FINAL 1 KEEPMOAT STADIUM, DONCASTER FRIDAY 29th JULY – 8PM

PLEASE NOTE THAT KEEPMOAT STADIUM IS A NON-SMOKING VENUE

To comply with the Green Travel Plan national environmental initiative, Keepmoat Stadium will encourage the allocation of all parking spaces to multi-occupancy vehicles carrying three or more people (dependant on vehicle size). For details of public transport timetables please visit South Yorkshire Travelwise. If you wish to travel to us by car, Keepmoat Stadium actively encourages you to consider car sharing.

By Road

Follow Yellow directional signs to Keepmoat Stadium are in place on the approach roads. Regular travel updates are given on TraxFM 107.1.

NB: There are scheduled roadworks on the M62 between North Cave junction 38 and Goole junction 36 from 8pm to 6am and East bound just lane closures.

Car Parking.

There is limited car parking on site at Keepmoat Stadium located on car park 3 at a cost of £5 per car on a first come first served basis. Cars will be directed to an available parking space by stadium stewards.

Free off-site parking is available at the Vue Cinema or Doncaster Dome (quarter of a mile from the stadium).

The Post Code for the Keepmoat Stadium is DN4 5JW. The Post Code for the Dome is DN4 7PD and the Post Code for the Vue Cinema is DN4 7NW

Coach Parking

Coach parking for Hull FC spectators will be on Stadium car park 4. Coach parking for Wigan Warriors spectators will be at the Dome – both official & unofficial. Temporary directional signage will be in place.

Local Transport

An enhanced bus service provided by First Bus (Services 72 & 75) will be in operation. These routes will start and terminate at the Frenchgate Bus Interchange. A 'Park and Walk' service will also be in operation from Doncaster Rovers former car park at Belle Vue. Directional signs will be in place to direct you to the Stadium.

The normal daily First Bus 72 & 75 service will operate every 30 minutes between 16:27 pm and 18:25 pm and every hour between 18:25pm and 23:35pm on Friday.

By Rail

Doncaster Interchange, located in the City Centre, is approximately 1 mile from Keepmoat Stadium.

A large crowd is expected for this match and traffic congestion is inevitable both before and after the matches. Please travel early to allow for any expected delays.

Parking for Disabled Supporters

There are 60 on-site dedicated accessible parking spaces at the stadium. To pre-book a space please contact Keepmoat Stadium Box Office on 01302 762576 and select option 1.

Turnstiles

Turnstiles will open at 18:30pm

Food & Drink

- ◆ Bars are open on the ground but close 10 minutes into the second half
- ♦ Alcoholic drinks are allowed to be taken into the stadium bowl
- ♦ There are bars in the concourse under all four sections of the stadium
- ♦ Hot and cold snacks & soft drinks are available in the ground from turnstiles opening through to the end of the game

Ground Regulations - In particular please note:

- Fireworks, smoke canisters, knives, bottles, glasses, cans,Or other articles which might be used as a weapon, missile, or used to cause annoyance are not permitted within the Ground and will be confiscated.
- Flags must be accompanied by a fire certificate and must not be on large poles
- The use of foul and abusive language, obscene chanting or racial abuse towards any person is strictly forbidden.
- Unauthorised persons are strictly forbidden from entering the field of play. Anyone doing so will be removed from the ground.
- The use of air horns, klaxons, whistles and any other item likely to cause confusion, annoyance or nuisance of any kind are not permitted in any part of the ground
- Spectators are not allowed to take alcohol into the Stadium
- All spectators entering the stadium are admitted subject to the understanding that they may be required to submit to a search to prevent dangerous items being brought into the ground which might be used to cause injury or damage to other people of property
- With the exception of authorised press representatives holding official passes, the taking pf photographs or cine/video photography inside the ground is prohibited.
- ♦ The stadium operates a rigorous Challenge 21 alcohol policy. ID will be required if purchaser looks under 21.
